

Show and Tell!

When your teacher tells you that 'Show and Tell' is on, you can create a post (instead of just typing a comment on a teacher's post) to tell or show us something that you have done this week. Just like at school, it could be about your learning or about another achievement. **It should be something you have achieved rather than images of something that belongs to you.** If you want to take part, follow these simple steps...

1. Click "Share something with your class" to create a new post.




2. Type in a message to tell us about what you have been up to.


3. Click 'Add', then 'File' to upload a picture of your work/ special achievement. (Make sure you only post pictures that follow our e-safety rules. You must ask a grown up at home before you post a picture.) You need to make sure your picture is already saved to your device before you try to add it to your post. Select the file from your device and click 'upload'.
