Dear Parents and carers,

We are pleased to say that we are able to continue to run a variety of sports and non-sports clubs across the week for the next half term.

We are incredibly grateful to the amazing staff we have here at Danson, who have given up their time to lead clubs enabling the children to have some wonderful additional opportunities and experiences beyond the classroom. It's been fantastic to hear that the children enjoyed the clubs that were run last year and this positive feedback means a lot to the staff who continue to go above and beyond for the children at Danson.

School Clubs

School clubs will be taking place next half term and the start date for these clubs will be the week commencing **11th November**. To apply for a school club, this must be done via Arbor and the allocation of places will be done on a **first come first served basis**. The date that you will be able to apply for the school clubs that are on offer will be **Monday 28th October** at 8pm which is during the half term break.

Please also note that once a club is full you will not be able to book via the Arbor system. In addition to this, if a child withdraws from a club after gaining a place, then another message will be sent to all parents explaining that there are additional places available and that you will need to apply for the club via the Arbor system. If there is not enough interest in the club, then it will not be run and this will also be communicated to you.

Payment

If you are successful in gaining a place for one of the clubs on offer, then payment must be made for your child to attend the club by **Wednesday 6th November**. All clubs will last five weeks and there will be no clubs running in the last week of the Autumn term. Therefore, a payment of £25.00 will need to be paid via Arbor. **If you fail to make the payment of £25.00 by Wednesday 6th November**, your child's place will be withdrawn from the club. If you are having any issues regarding the payment for the club, then please speak to the school office.

We would urge you to make sure that you are on time to collect your child, late collections impact on the staff running the club and may mean they choose not to run a club in the future. As with our normal procedures, if you are late and it is longer than 15 minutes, then your child will be taken to the After School Club and you will be charged for their attendance. We appreciate that sometimes circumstances mean that you may be delayed, but if you continue to collect your child late then your child will be withdrawn from the club that they have been attending.
