To those who are celebrating we wish you happy Diwali and a prosperous New Year!





On Monday 9th November, Year 3 and 4 were given the fantastic opportunity to virtually meet the author Marie Basting via Google Meet in their classrooms. Marie is the author of the excellent book Princess BMX (aimed at <u>7-9 year</u> olds), which challenges stereotypes and encourages children to be more BMX. Being more BMX means, in Marie's words, being resilient, bouncing back from mistakes and set-backs, hard work and being a team player. This message echoes many of our Danson Values and is something that Danson pupils know is at the heart of life-long learning and growth!

Year 3 and 4 pupils asked some thought-provoking questions using Blooms Taxonomy higher-order thinking including: What is the link between the Princess in the story and you? Is the character based on you or a real person? Marie Basting gave Year 3 and 4 some insightful answers which covered information about her own childhood and struggles throughout her own journey to becoming a writer.

Well done to Year 3 and 4 for asking a great range of questions and thank you once again to Marie Basting for her time and aspirational messages about defying expectations and achieving your dreams. I think we should try to be more BMX every day!
