Dear Children, Mums, Dads and Carers,

THANK YOU AND WELL DONE

To all the children for working so hard this year and to their parents and carers for your support and encouragement.

Thank you also for the appreciation you have shown the teachers and support for members of staff with your kind words and kind gifts. They mean so much to everyone here at Danson and gives us all a welcome boost to keep us going.

ATTENDANCE

As you all know we are working hard to improve attendance in school starting this year with our Achilles attendance certificates and badges. We were so pleased to see a much larger number of children getting their bronze badges this term and their enthusiasm for trying next school year to go for silver and gold. The Department for Education recognise and support the efforts schools are making to increase attendance overall.

Please see below excerpts from the letter that The Rt Hon Gillian Keegan MP Secretary of State for Education sent to schools.

"I am writing to thank you for your continued hard work and dedication in supporting strong attendance and ensuring that children and young people across mainstream schools, special schools and alternative provision receive an excellent education.

But there is more to do, with absence rates still well above pre-Covid levels, improving attendance is a top priority for me and the Department. The steps we take now will be critical to the start of the next academic year. I want to ensure that as many children as possible in mainstream and specialist settings are present from day one.

So, I ask you to continue the excellent work you do each day to support children to attend from the first day of term. I want to work with you and others to offer the warmest of welcomes to children and families for September, resetting expectations with children and families so attendance levels continue to recover.

Those first days back really matter. Evidence from a recent Children's Commissioner report showed that children who miss days 2, 3 and 4 of the new term for unauthorised reasons had a predicted overall absence of almost 45%, or 31 days across the term, compared to children who missed days near the end of term, with a predicted overall absence of 20-30%.

The NHS advises that it is fine to send children to school with a minor cough or cold provided they don't have a temperature and what parents can do if their child is facing attendance challenges."

We are delighted to share some news about two of our Year three pupils. Matthew and Nicole Mao recently came first in their Latin and Ballroom dancing event at the NATD 2023 in Blackpool. We are so very proud of you, congratulations to you both!


Denis & Myra, year 5, Danson Primary School, London
