Department for Education (DfE) Statutory Requirements for Relationships and Health Education

As a school community, we are committed to working in partnership with parents and all stakeholders and we would invite you to engage in a process of information sharing and gathering around the proposed changes to the R.S.E. curriculum.

Attached to this e-mail is a copy of the draft RSE policy for you to read and a survey which provides you with the opportunity to put forward your thoughts and questions. I have also shared with you a copy of our PSHE long term curriculum plan and a brief outline of what each year will be covering in the statutory RSE curriculum. Please bear in mind that the RSE curriculum is statutory and as a school we are obligated to teach the required content.

As part of our parental consultation, I would also like to invite you to attend a virtual parent information session which will provide you with further information, examples of resources we will be using with the children during RSE lessons and for us to provide feedback to the parent survey.
