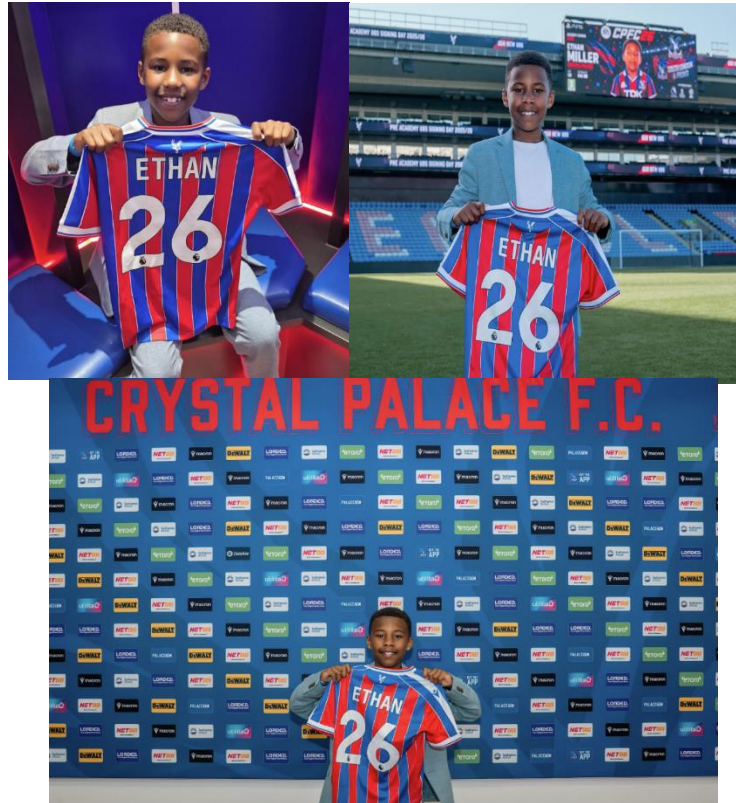
Competing against schools from across the borough, the team achieved an outstanding 5th place out of more than 60 schools – a remarkable achievement for their first tournament.

Congratulations to Lilly for reaching the semi-finals of the NATD Medalist of the Year Grand Finals in Blackpool!

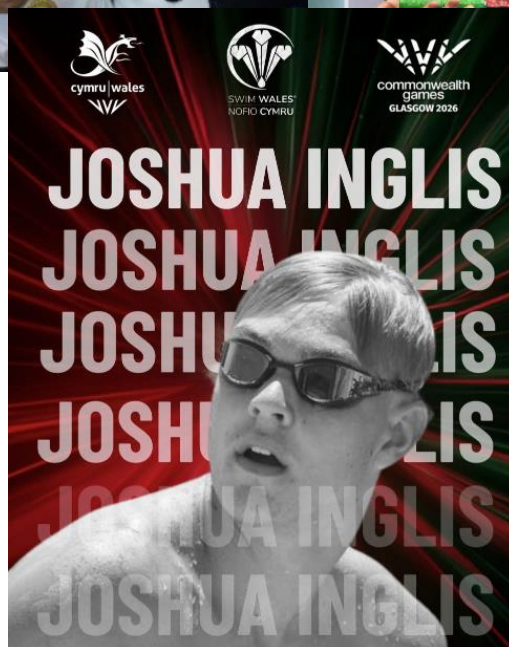
